

2011 Volleyball Schedule

Sunday, January 30th, 8pm: Mandatory Coaches First Meeting

Coaches need to attend to this meeting with their proposed rosters and important “No Availability Dates”. Playoff and tournament dates will be confirmed and decided at this first meeting and will not be changed.

Tuesday, February 8th, 8pm: Mandatory Coaches Scheduling Meeting

At this meeting, all coaches should be present with their schools calendar. Every team will be given a copy of the latest NCAA rule book, the Youth Volleyball League modified rules, the modified non-deciding and deciding game score sheets, the Libero tracking sheet and the lineup sheet. A class will be offered to teach coaches/assistants how to keep score using these sheets. **NOTE:** Directions on how to fill all the score and tracking sheets are contained in the NCAA rule book.

Date/Time To Be Determined: Referee Meeting (Not For Coaches)

The Board Of Directors will meet with the referees to discuss what is expected of them, to clarify many uncertainties encountered and to ensure that the referees are familiar with the rules of the league. The referees will have an opportunity to express their issues and concerns as well.

Sunday, February 27th, 7:00pm-10:00pm: “Official Scoring and Coach’s Etiquette Class”

At this class, the Board Of Directors will teach everyone how to officially keep score using the “Non-Deciding Game” and “Deciding Game” sheets, as well as how to use the “Lineup” and “Libero Tracking” sheets. In addition, the coaches will be instructed about proper coaching etiquettes, such as ‘how to line up girls’, ‘how to sub girls’, ‘how to switch sides’, ‘how to ask for a line-up/score-check’, etc. Any coaches, assistants or scorers are encouraged to attend this class. Although this class is optional, it is highly recommended

Sunday, February 27th, 7:00pm: Registration Fee and Document Deadline

The league should already have received in-hand each team’s roster, CCD letters, registration fee and coach’s code of conduct by this date. Paperwork and fees will be accepted at the meeting on February 27th. Failure to hand in any and all fees and paperwork will result in the penalties mentioned in the rule and regulations.

Tuesday, March 1st: Season Opens – First Day Of Games

Friday, May 6th: All Star & Serving Derby Nominations Due

Saturday, May 21st: Season Ends - Last Day Of Games

Morning Of Sunday, May 22nd: Tie-Breaker/Make-up Games – This rarely happens

Tie-Breaker Games: Tie-breaker games will only be needed if all other attempts (as listed on the website) to break the tie fail. If, however, they do need to be played, then all teams needing to break a tie must be present and must play the game. If a team forfeits a tie-breaker game, then they will be un-eligible for playoffs and will also forfeit playoffs.

Make Up Games: If an unforeseen, unavoidable event (such as harsh weather conditions) causes a game to be cancelled and the team cannot agree upon a re-schedule date, the make up games need to be played. All teams needing to make up a game must be present and must play the game. If a team forfeits a make up game, then they will be un-eligible for playoffs and will also forfeit playoffs.

Sunday, May 22nd: Division Champs Awards Ceremony, 7pm

Many times in the past the division champs get knocked out in the playoffs and don’t make it to the tournament – never being acknowledged by the league for their accomplishment. This awards ceremony is for the JV and Varsity Division Champs (players to come in team uniforms and any spectators welcomed – admission is free) to receive their trophies. Place to be determined.
